- Memorize the GR-821st Chain of Command
- Memorize AFJROTC Ranks
- Memorize Active Duty Ranks
- March a flight using the 30 commands
- Set an example as a excellent cadet
- Attend at least one event per quarter (Drill Team counts)
- Maintain at least a B- in AFJROTC
- Promotion Board
- Meet 70% overall for rank

Those testing to become a NCO must do the following:

- Memorize National Chain of Command
- Memorize GR-821st Chain of Command
- Memorize Active Duty Ranks
- Memorize AFJROTC Ranks

- March a flight using the 44 commands
- March a flight using the 59 commands (Captain to Colonel only)
- Set an example as a excellent cadet
- Attend majority events every quarter
- Maintain at least an A- in AFJROTC
- Promotion Board
- Meet 90% overall for rank
